On February 8, 2017, at a regularly scheduled, duly noticed monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of six out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned item came before us.

During the meeting the commissioners voted unanimously, 6:0:0, to support the NoMa BID plan to install an art and lighting project under the train tracks overpass on L Street N.E. we understand the title of the project is "Lightweave" and it consists of chains of lattices of color-changing light tubes suspended above the walkway. The lights are interactive and respond to movement or sound.

The commissioners approved the design but noted for the record that the lighting needs to be much brighter than the current levels.
