On June 14, 2017, at a duly noticed regularly scheduled monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of six out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned matter came before ANC 6C.

The ANC 6C commissioners voted unanimously, 6:0:0, to protest this license application on the basis of disturbance to the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood; negative impact on nearby property values, and negative impact on vehicular traffic. The vote included designation of Mr. Steve O'Neal, chair of the ANC 6C Alcoholic Beverage Committee, to represent ANC 6C in all matters pertaining to this license application, with ANC6C05 Commissioner Christopher Miller as his alternate.

The commissioners hope to work with the applicant to obtain a settlement agreement between the establishment and ANC 6C representing the neighborhood. The vote also included approval of a stipulated license contingent upon completion and signing of the settlement agreement.
