Re: 301 N Street NE, application 203998, traffic control plan and public space construction for new development; Proposed traffic control plan includes closing N Street NE to avoid trucks using residential streets

Dear Mr. Marcou,

On June 14, 2017, at a duly noticed regularly scheduled monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of six out of six commissioners and the public present, the current matter came before ANC 6C.

The commissioners understand that the traffic control plan directs truck traffic to enter the work site on N Street NE from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street NE and exit from N Street onto Florida Avenue. Trucks will not be allowed to travel south on 4<sup>th</sup> Street Ne (a restricted route) after exiting the site. The commissioners believe that this will have minimal impact on the neighborhood.

The N Street streetscape plan includes bays for cars traveling on N Street NE to pull into for passenger loading and unloading. Between the bays are greenery and seating elements. Bike racks are provided. The commissioners voted unanimously, 6:0:0, to support the traffic control and streetscape plan.
