It is our understanding in ANC 6C that ABRA postponed the protest hearing for this case at the request of this ANC and with the approval of the applicant. Our September meeting had to be changed from September 13 to September 19 due to a lack of a quorum of commissioners on September 13.

On September 19, 2017, at a duly noticed regularly scheduled monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of four out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned matter came before ANC 6C.

The ANC 6C commissioners voted unanimously, 4:0:0, to protest this license application on the basis of disturbance to the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood; negative impact on nearby property values, and negative impact on vehicular traffic. The discussion included designation of Jason Starr, a member of the ANC 6C Alcoholic Beverage Licensing Committee, to represent ANC 6C in all matters pertaining to this license application, with Steve O'Neal, the chair of that committee, as his alternate.

The commissioners hope to work with the applicant to obtain a settlement agreement.

Thank you for giving great weight to recommendations of ANC 6C.
