On November 8, 2017, at a duly noticed, regularly scheduled, monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of six out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned matter came before ANC 6C.

The commissioners voted unanimously, 6:0:0, to protest this new license on the basis of disturbance to the peace, order, and quiet of the community; the negative effect on nearby property values; and the negative impact on vehicular traffic.

The commissioners hope to negotiate a settlement agreement with the applicant on behalf of the residents.

Part of the vote designated Mr. Steve O'Neal, citizen chair of the ANC 6C Alcoholic Beverage Licensing Committee, as the primary ANC 6C representative in all matters pertaining to this application, with ANC 6C06 Commissioner Heather Edelman as his alternate backup.
