Dear Mr. Rodriguez,

On November 8, 2017, at a duly noticed, regularly scheduled, monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of six out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned matter came before ANC 6C.

Diane Romo Thomas, community relations representative for the marathons, presented the following information on the event for 2018:

- There will be no change to course or timing from the past two years.
- MPD will be posted at Union Station to ensure buses do not turn right and get stuck on 3rd Street.
- Large signs will be posted along the course on the Saturday before the event and will be taken down on Sunday following the event. Door-to-door flyers will be distributed. The course will be posted on the event website.
- 13th Street problems will be addressed, and MPD is encouraged to look at Maryland Avenue as a possible "bump route." Additional officers will be posted at that intersection to manage it.

The commissioners voted unanimously, 6:0:0, to support the race provided the above-mentioned conditions are met.
