Dear Mr. Moosally,

This letter supersedes the one sent on November 11 from ANC 6C with more specific language. Please remove the previous letter and replace it with this one.

On November 8, 2017, at a duly noticed, regularly scheduled, monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of six out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned matter came before ANC 6C.

The commissioners voted unanimously, 6:0:0, to protest this new license on the basis of (1) the effect of the establishment on property values; (2) the effect of the establishment on the peace, order, and quiet, including the noise and litter provisions set forth in Sections 25-725 and 25-726 of the D.C. Code; and (3) the effect of the establishment upon residential parking needs and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

The commissioners hope to negotiate a settlement agreement with the applicant on behalf of the residents.

Part of the vote designated ANC 6C04 Commissioner Mark Eckenwiler and ANC 6C05 Commissioner Chris Miller as representatives in all matters pertaining to this application.

Thank you for giving great weight to recommendations of ANC 6C.
