Dear Mr. Moosally,

On December 14, 2017, at a duly noticed, regularly scheduled, monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of five out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned matter came before ANC 6C.

The commissioners voted unanimously, 6:0:0, to protest this new license on the basis of (1) the effect of the establishment on property values; (2) the effect of the establishment on the peace, order, and quiet, including the noise and litter provisions set forth in Sections 25-725 and 25-726 of the D.C. Code; and (3) the effect of the establishment upon residential parking needs and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

The commissioners hope to negotiate a settlement agreement with the applicant on behalf of the residents.

The vote included designation of Mr. Steve O'Neal, citizen chair of the ANC 6C Alcoholic Beverage Licensing Committee, as representative of ANC 6C in all matters pertaining to this application, with ANC 6C05 Commissioner Chris Miller as his alternate.
