1. **NoMA Parks Foundation:** update on status of pending parks projects.

2. **Legislative Matters:** On January 10, 2018 the DC Council's Committee on Transportation and the Environment will hold a public hearing regarding two parks-related bills: B22-39, the Community Use of School Facilities Task Force Establishment Act of 2017 and B22-613, the Ensuring Community Access to Recreational Spaces Act of 2017. The Committee will discuss the bills and, as applicable, make recommendations to ANC 6C for submission of public commentary:
