Dear Mr. Marcou,

On January 10, 2018, at a duly noticed regularly scheduled monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of five out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned matter came before ANC 6C.

The ANC 6C commissioners voted unanimously, 5:0:0, to object to the application in its current form due to insufficient detail provided on the proposed enclosures, including design, materials, operation, and amount of seating. We have concerns that a large number of patrons could cause a disturbance to the neighborhood and that the structures may be unsightly and diminish the pedestrian experience. Sufficient detail was not provided in the plans to accurately assess these impacts. However, we will withdraw our objections if the applicant voluntarily postpones the hearing and provides the additional information for our review at a future public meeting of ANC 6C.

Thank you for giving great weight to recommendations of ANC 6C.
