Dear Mr. Moosally,

On January 10, 2018, at a duly noticed regularly scheduled monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of five out of six commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned matter came before ANC 6C.

The ANC 6C commissioners voted unanimously, 5:0:0, to protest this license application on the basis of disturbance to the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood. We protest both sales limited to hotel guests and sales that are offered to anyone. The CCNV shelter is one block away, and the director, Mr. Rico Harris, stated that single sales would have a negative impact on CCNV residents who have alcohol addiction problems.

The vote included designation of ANC 6C02 Commissioner Karen Wirt to represent ANC 6C in all matters pertaining to this license application, with Mr. Steve O'Neal, chair of the ANC 6C Alcoholic Beverage Committee, as her alternate.
